E. COMMITTEE/COUNCIL REPORTS

- District Facilities Committee (DFC) Atheria Smith
 - The DFC reviewed their Goals at their last committee meeting.
- District Technology Committee (DTC) Antoine Mehouelley
 - The bulk of the last DTC meeting was dedicated to Peoplesoft 9.2 Training. Extensive reports from constituents.
 - Moving forward with HR implementation, but the go-live date may be delayed.
- District Academic Affairs and Student Services Committee
 - There is no further discussion or movement forward on the District Enrollment Management Sub-Committee.
- Planning & Budgeting Council *Thomas Renbarger*
 - A report on the Tentative Budget was presented to the PBC.
 Working to confirm a BAM that takes into consideration the SCFF.
 The plan is to have a recommendation for the Board to consider by sometime in Sept or Oct.
 - Concern was expressed that there was no shared governance input on the budget given the adjustments made after the May revise. The PBC Committee voted against approving the budget given that it doesn't include the COLA. This is still being negotiated.
 - 2 recent motion's passed related to budget development.

The Plan has been endorsed by the four faculty senates, the DAS, the Laney Health &Safety Committee and the Board. The plan is to have a document and have the District agree to work towards this holistic plan for safety and wellness. More was discussed about what is being done outside of the change in security firms. Update on Tentative Budget (including staff hires)	Adil Ahmed & Jannett Jackson	Discussion	 The Tentative Budget - 5 Year Projection, including the staff hires - It was noted that there is no COLA included. The \$6M surplus (includes COLA) and \$4.4M (with frozen positions) Shared different scenarios for Fund Balances given various assumptions (including with and without the Hold Harmless - this amount increases annually- and one vs. multiple year COLAs.) Chancellor Jackson noted that the District will be conducting a classification study. We will need funds to address appropriate changes according to where we fall within a comparison of compensation ranges across the Bay 10 colleges. The \$4.4M frozen positions will not return if we do not increase enrollment to address our budget deficit. Concerns were expressed about the District's priorities and cuts to faculty. VC Ahmed noted that he would present all 3 scenarios. It was noted that there is a report due to State at the end of the month to address the FCMAT Recommendations. We have not yet fully addressed all recommendations. It was clarified that this agenda item is not presented as an action item Colleges to be able to maintain carryover surplus balances.

Update on Strategic Planning and the District's Mission Statement	Jannett Jackson	Discussion	 Will be bringing back a discussion on the District's Mission to the Board with examples of other District statements through-out the region. Are currently moving forward with the District's Strategic Plan An Environmental Scan will be done at the District level (a regional scan) – to complete this asap so that colleges can move forward with their educational master planning. It was noted that we need the Board to provide input or edits to the mission, so that we can move forward.
