The Board is committed to assessing its own performance as a Board in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning.

To that end, the Board has established the following process:

The Peralta Governing Board will conduct a formal self-evaluation on an annual basis during the months of June/July. The self-evaluation form will be circulated to each of the Trustees on or about the 1st of June. Trustees shall complete the form and deliver a copy to the Board President no later than the 15th of June. This document will be used as the foundation for a formal discussion during a workshop scheduled in conjunction with the end of June Board meeting or a July Board meeting. The goal of the self-evaluation will be to share views, values, concerns, priorities, and recommendations among the Trustees. The Board's self-evaluation also shall include goals and objectives related to the District's and the Board's commitment to anti-racism, diversity, equity, and inclusion

In addition, the evaluation of the Chancellor also will be conducted in June.

The results of this process will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year
