

Campus Safety Summary



The majority of PCCD respondents indicated that they felt 'Very safe' or 'Somewhat safe' on campus.

College of Alameda	65%
Laney College	63%
Merritt College	63%

Although the majority of respondents at PCCD feel safe on campus, this report focuses on the subset of respondents that indicated feeling 'unsafe' or 'somewhat unsafe' on campus. Respondents with safety concerns were asked to provide details about their experiences regarding campus safety. The following items were coded, "Are there any particular areas/buildings at Peralta campus(es) where you feel less safe?" and the open-ended follow-up item, "Do you want to share more details about your experience with a member of the research team so that we could improve the situation?"

Although the majority of respondents comments about unsafe areas/buildings were related to Laney College, it is worth noting that **2 comments** about Berkeley City College were also about safety concerns related to the **surrounding city**



Perceptions of Campus Safety

A total of 45 responses were coded across the four PCCD campuses for the survey item below.

"Do you want to share more details about your experience with a member of the research team so that we could improve the situation?"

Top themes related to safety concerns mentioned in comments

<u>Laney College</u>

Crime 16%

EX: "Laney has the most **crime**. There's shattered glass on the parking lot grounds from car break-

13% Lack of visibility (cameras, lighting, seclusion)

Ex: "Evaluate areas which may need additional lighting around the campus. Some areas are not well lit & may be useful for ambush."

Unhoused population

EX: "Homeless people park all around the parking lot, there is no way to avoid passing by as there is only one entrance for school now. There is no vigilance around the parking lot."

Merritt College

Crime 4%

EX: "Nothing happened to me, but I know there are a lot of people living on the streets who are always around as well as people that use drugs and sell."

4% Parking Lot

EX: "Also in the parking lot we need more security [especially] later evening."

Berkeley City College

4% Sexual Harassment

EX: "I experienced being followed by another student on many occasions while in campus building. He approached me more than once to ask inappropriate things while I was in the hallways. I would prefer to have no further conversation on the subject, but would like to feel safer on campus."

College of Alameda

Lack of visibility 4% (cameras, lighting, seclusion)

EX: "It isn't that I have something happened to me that made me feel that type of way but since [COVID] started there are **fewer** people going around and the silence sometimes makes you look behind your back often.

Parking Lot

EX: "A family member was robbed in the CoA parking lot a couple years ago."
