Identifying Four-Year Concurrent Students

- Have not earned a bachelor's degree or higher

AND EITHER


- Have a concurrent enrollment at a four-year college or university based on National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) records

(For summer terms: includes enrollment in the summer, prior spring, or following fall)

OR


- Indicated an educational goal of "Four-year student taking classes" in Campus Solutions or in their most recent CCCApply application on or prior to the enrollment term
- Evidence of recent enrollment at a four-year college (from CCCApply or MIS transfer file)

Headcounts by Four-Year College Category




Headcounts of Last Three Years - District

- Headcount decrease in AY2025 due to partial NSC data availability




Headcounts of Last Three Years - Colleges

- Berkeley and Laney had the highest enrollment headcounts




FTES by Four-Year College Category




FTES of Last Three Years - District

- Berkeley and Laney had the highest FTES






Session Type of Four-Year Students – District

- **8W2, Intersession, and 14W are next highest session types**



Overall Course Modality – District


- Hybrid is the least popular while online is more than 84%
- In-person has increased more than 8% last three years




In-Person Course Modality – Colleges



Hybrid Course Modality – Colleges








- **Asynchronous is the most popular at more than 85%**
- **Mixed online the least popular**




Asynchronous Online Course Modality – Colleges
