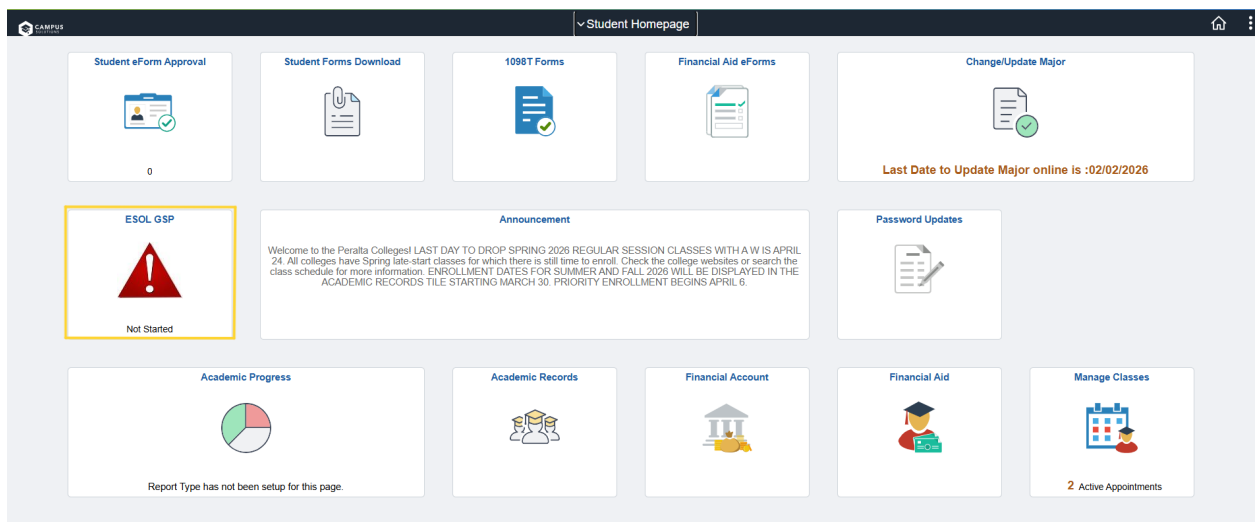


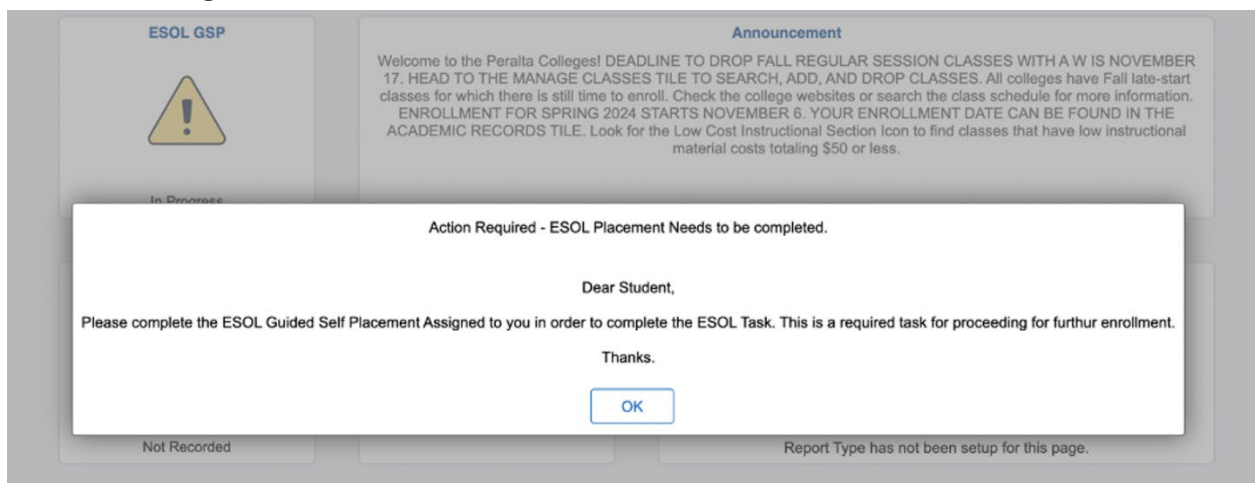
# Guided Self Placement (GSP) Student Support Guide

1. Sign in to **Campus Solutions** and click the ESOL GSP tile to get started - <https://myapplications.microsoft.com>. (Please note that course enrollment is restricted until the GSP is completed. If you are providing another English test, such as TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo instead, reach out to your Intl. Admissions Advisor and let them know.)

Note: You are NOT required to enroll in the suggested courses at the end of your Assessment.

### What can you do in English?

Think about your reading and writing in English. Choose the level that is closest to what you can do. Then, click the green "next" button to continue.

- Basic - Basic English**  
I do not know any English. / No se inglesa / 我不懂英文 / Je ne connais pas l'anglais / मुझे अंग्रेजी नहीं आती है / أنا لا أعرف الإنجليزية
- Level 1 - High Beginning**
  - read and follow directions in a textbook or worksheet
  - write sentences
  - listen to and follow simple instructions in class
  - write 5-10 sentences about a topic
- Level 2 - Intermediate**
  - read stories in English
  - read short news stories with a dictionary
  - use present, past, and future tenses
  - write a paragraph about one idea
- Level 3 - High Intermediate**
  - understand the main ideas in newspapers and magazines even if I do not understand all of the details
  - read a short book in English with a dictionary
  - write a 3-4 paragraph essay giving my opinion about a topic
- Level 4 - Advanced**
  - understand almost all of what I read in newspapers and magazines
  - read fiction and nonfiction books in English
  - write a 3-5 page essay presenting an argument on a topic with support from other texts
