

Parking Regulations and Citation

Parking permits are required at all times Monday - Sunday (except school holidays).

Section 21113A of the California Vehicle Code grant the authority for the Peralta Community College District Department of Community Safety to enforce ALL Vehicle Code violations on the parking lots and roadways within the District property. In addition, the District may adopt its own regulations, to provide adequate parking and the safe movement of pedestrians and vehicles.

The following information is posted at the entrance to college parking lots:

- Valid permits are required at all times (school holidays excluded)
- Park in marked stalls only
- Obey posted signs and markings
- No parking between 11pm and 5am
- Vehicles parked over 72 hours will be towed at owner's expense
- Illegally parked vehicles will be cited or towed
- Authority by 21113A CVC
- No motorhome or bus parking in any lot. Team busses must make arrangements with Community Safety prior to arrival

The above regulations apply 365 days a year unless otherwise noted. Illegally parked vehicles can be cited and/or towed, even if the class is not in session. Read all signs and road markings carefully. Be sure to park only in a marked stall, clearly display your permit, and lock your vehicle.

Parking permits are required Monday through Sunday (except school holidays) even if a class is not in session.

Pay Parking Citation

- You may pay your citation by mailing the fine to the address indicated on the citation.
- You may pay by phone by calling 1-800-989-2058. When using the automated service, please have your citation number or vehicle license plate number available.

To set up a payment plan, citizens can contact Citation Processing Center at (800) 989-2058. There is a \$25 administrative fee that is added to the first installment of the payment plan to start this service.
