Donald Moore spoke to how the PGC changed some of the wording (not comprehensive changes) from what was presented by the PBC. To go back to the minutes to confirm. Chancellor Walter proposed that we move forward with the Mission Statement that was recommended to the Chancellor from PGC and use that as what we present to the Board. May need to craft some sort of policy that allows for some conversation with the Board.
