Brahmbhatt, Consultant with Cambridge West Partnership  Through the BAM Model it is possible the Budget Calendar may move earlier because some of the items need to begin as soon as the budget is adopted from the previous year.  Items reviewed at the BAM Taskforce mainly focused on FTES, SCFF, and 320 Report.
